

NEXT PRESIDENT OF THE CATHOLIC INSTITUTE OF SYDNEY ANNOUNCED



The Chancellor of the Catholic Institute of Sydney, Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP, has announced that Sr Dr Isabell Naumann will be appointed the next President of the Catholic Institute of Sydney. Sr Isabell has been a lecturer in Theology at CIS since 2005. During that time she has also been the Dean of Studies at the Seminary of the Good Shepherd. Sr Isabell will take up this appointment at the beginning of the first semester 2018. Sr Isabell succeeds Rev. Dr Gerard Kelly, who commenced as President at the beginning of 2004.

The Chancellor has also announced that Dr Rohan Curnow will be appointed as Deputy President. He will assume this role in conjunction with his current role of Academic Dean. Dr Curnow has been a lecturer in Theology at CIS since 2010.
